WHAT A DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES

All Saints Catholic College

Last year, 63% of Fast Forward students who completed high school, were made offers to study at a university (464 students). The percentage of students being made these offers has steadily grown since the program began and we are very proud of the student achievements and the role we have played, along with our partner schools, in contributing to these results.

All Saints Catholic College has partnered in the Fast Forward program with Western Sydney University since 2011.

Below is a snapshot of your school's involvement in the program throughout the year:



In 2017

- 14 STUDENTS ATTENDED THE YEAR 10 UNI DAY (82.35% of students in program)
- 9 STUDENTS ATTENDED THE YEAR 9 WELCOME EVENING (47.00% of students in program)
- 8 STUDENTS ATTENDED THE YEAR 9 UNI DAY (42% of students in program)
- 1 IN-SCHOOL WORKSHOP HELD

Since 2013, the Fast Forward program has also offered the Studiosity service to program participants, providing an online homework centre which includes free online tutoring and the use of an extensive bank of practice questions and quizzes for revision and study throughout the year.

In 2017, students from All Saints Catholic College accessed 614 minutes across 28 tutorials from Studiosity.

Carol Richardson, the Fast Forward Project Officer working with All Saints Catholic College, advises that Vanessa Riga is a committed Fast Forward contact who has ensured that the students have attended the on-campus events and has facilitated some in-school workshops.
